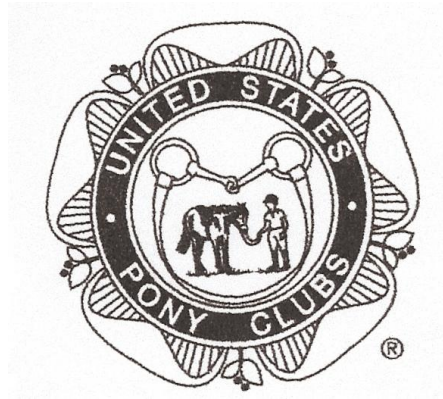
Jumping in the morning starting with pile of poles up to...?

What is Pony Club?

In a nut shell, Pony Club was started to help young riders learn not only riding skills, but horse management skills, in a safe and controlled environment.

This organization teaches children about the whole horse. They challenge the mind at **Quiz** with tables of items that teach them about shoeing, vetting, feeding, tack, poisonous plants, lameness, stabling, hauling, horse sports, fox hunting, and much more.

Mounted Rallies are a competition that takes place across the USA and many other countries. There will be a region level and then a championship level. There are **International competitions** available for kids in both the unmounted and mounted rallies.

Kids will compete on a 4 to 5 person team. The competition is judged not only on the discipline but on the set up of the tack room, feed room, and horse stall.
